## HAD SEVENTY-SEVEN GRANDCHILDREN

**In Addition Mrs. Freelove Kathan Left  
101 Great-Grandchildren and Three  
Great-Great-Grandchildren.**

Saratoga, N. Y., June 18. —Mrs. Freelove Kathan, widow of Luke Kathan, who died in her 90th year a few days ago, at her home in Conklingville, Saratoga County, was the mother of six sons and nine daughters, all of whom reached married life, and eleven of whom are now living. She had 102 grandchildren, 77 of whom are living; 101 great-grandchildren, all now living; and three great-great-grandchildren, all of whom survive her. Four generations of her descendants were represented at her funeral. She married at the age of 15.

Her father, David Allen, was born in Rhode Island, and he died at the age of 95 years. Her mother died at the age of 70. Her parents had eleven children, all of whom married, and had 96 grandchildren, more than 100 great-grandchildren, and 7 great-great-grandchildren when they died. Mrs. Kathan's oldest child is 72 years old and the youngest is 41.
